
Head of School




IB PRIMARY YEARS PROGRAMME (PYP)

SCHOLE offers IB PRIMARY YEARS PROGRAMME (PYP) with internationally certified & experienced teachers to ensure a world class standard of teaching. We follow the famous Kath-Murdoch Cycle of Inquiry which provokes critical thinking, action and reflection.

Primary Years Programme is a curriculum framework designed for students aged 3 to 12. It prepares students for intellectual challenges of further education and their future careers, focusing on the development of the whole child as an inquirer, both in the classroom and the world outside.

The PYP aims to create a curriculum that is engaging, relevant, significant, and challenging for learners. PYP students are well prepared for the next stage of education, including participation in the Middle Years Programme (MYP).



Language Arts / Literacy

The development of language is fundamental to the need to communicate; it supports and enhances our thinking and understanding. Language permeates the world in which we live and is socially constructed and dependent on our social interactions. We aim for our students to be exposed to the world through written and spoken word.

Mathematics / Numeracy

We view mathematics primarily as a vehicle to support inquiry and providing a global language through which we make sense of the world around us. Our students become competent users of the language of mathematics and begin to use it only as a way of thinking, as opposed to seeing it only as a series of facts and equations to be memorised which helps them develop essential problem solving skills.

Science

The inclusion of science in our curriculum leads our students to an appreciation and awareness of the world. It encourages curiosity and ingenuity and enables our students to develop an understanding of the world. Reflection on scientific knowledge also helps our students to develop a sense of responsibility regarding the impact of their actions on themselves, others and their world. Our students are taught to combine scientific knowledge with reasoning and thinking skills.

Social Studies

Social Studies encourage curiosity and develop an understanding of a rapidly changing world. Through social studies, our students develop an understanding of their personal and cultural identities. They develop the skills and knowledge needed to participate actively in their classroom, their school, their community and the world.

Physical Education

Our students experience a range of physical activities tailored to fit their age, abilities and interests including athletics, games and gymnastics. P.E contributes in maintaining well-being and is intrinsically linked to all aspects of their developmental milestones.

Creative Arts

Arts provide our students with a wide range of opportunities and means to respond to their experiences and engage with historical, social and cultural perspectives while promoting attitudes of empathy and appreciation. We endeavour to articulate our student's thoughts in new ways through dance, drama, music and visual art.

EARLY YEARS PROGRAMME (EYP)

We follow a Montessori inspired and activity based learning curriculum for our younger students. The main aim of our Early Year curriculum is to provide a firm foundation for learning. We build on children's skills, attitudes and knowledge in different areas of learning which includes personal, social and emotional development, physical development, communication and language, mathematics, literacy, and understanding of the world.

Our students learn and develop in different ways through challenging and playful opportunities. We look, listen, and note where an individual child is on the development pathway and how each child learns best.




IB MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP)

The Middle Years Programme (MYP) is a five-year programme designed for learners aged 11–16 by the International Baccalaureate (IB). The MYP curriculum contains eight subject groups, providing a broad and balanced education. Students who complete the MYP are well-prepared to undertake the IB Diploma Programme (DP) or equivalents in the Cambridge system, such as A Levels/Intermediate etc.

Flexible framework

The programme's flexible curriculum is compatible with national systems of education and able to meet local and national requirements. Our MYP students are prepared and undertake the Pakistan Studies and Islamiyat O Levels, along with their MYP programme.

INQUIRY-BASED CONCEPT-DRIVEN CURRICULUM

Inquiry-based, concept-driven curriculum

The MYP ensures breadth and depth of understanding through study in eight subject groups. Addressing the intellectual, social, emotional and physical well-being of students holistically, the MYP prepares them to take principled action by participating in service within the community and requiring study of at least two languages (language of instruction and additional language of choice) to support the understanding of their own cultures and those of others.

MYP students engage with big ideas, rather than simply memorizing facts in order to prepare for exams. As a result, they develop learning skills that they can rely on throughout the course of their independent, purpose-driven lives.



Beyond the classroom our students enjoy an extensive range of extra-curricular and enrichment activities. Highly committed and hard-working staff and trained coaches ensure that our students can benefit from: sport, music and drama; taking part in charity events, community work or enterprise challenges; social activities; playing and having fun together. Curricular and extra-curricular trips and visits also add to the students' wider learning and offer exciting opportunities for personal development. At Schole we encourage all students to participate in extra-curricular activities as we believe these strengthen the students' interests and talent.
